RECIPE OF THE MONTH

BLACK RUSSIAN CAKE

(Barb Reinhart)

1 yellow cake mix
 1 box chocolate instant pudding
 1-cup oil
 4 eggs
 ¼ cup vodka
 ¼ cup kahlua
 ¾ cup water

Mix all ingredients for 3 minutes. Bake in greased and floured bundt or tube pan at 350° for 50-60 minutes in pan. Remove and glaze when cool.

Glaze: 1 cup powdered sugar, 1 tablespoon kahlua. Mix both ingredients. Add more kahlua for desired consistency. Drizzle over cake.
