Perspective from the Pew



Last Sunday I observed, not for the first time mind you, the fascination we have with our phones. In God's house, we are looking at Facebook, and all the recent posts from our "friends." Then I noticed that it is everywhere; the phone has become our primary form of entertainment. We count the number of "friends" we have, or the number of "followers" on Twitter. I must say the worst thing I have seen, was a family, out for dinner at a nice restaurant, all looking at their phones.

Theologians, philosophers, poets, songwriters, novelists, film makers, sociologists, anthropologists, and psychologists have all dealt with the topic of friends. Song lyrics and quotes by famous and not so famous people abound on the topic.

The best quote on friendship of all comes from the best friend of all: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (Jn. 15:13)

Who is this friend we have? Do we really know Him? How much do we know about Him? We often lose sight that Jesus came to us, we did not have to accept His friend request, and if we are in the pew, we have chosen to follow Him. His friendship does not arise from necessity, we have entered into it freely.

Friendship is based on a disinterested love for the unique characteristics of the other. Friendship forms strong bonds and the betrayal of a friend ranks as the most dastardly of deeds, as I am sure some of us know all too well.

It is in the silence, the stillness, when I am not doing anything at all but just sitting and being open that I find my friend. I may not hear Him, but I know in my heart what He wants from me, where He wants to lead me.

I suggest you try doing the same, just sitting and listening. There should be no distractions. The only acceptable distraction is the feeling of the wind blowing on your face, or perhaps birds singing, or even the warmth of the sun.

Turn off the phone, the television, computer and all the other electronic gadgets you may own. Go for a walk or just sit, and re-discover our friend. The One who died for us, His friends.

What have you got to lose, for He will never "Un-Friend" or "Block" you.
