Perspective from the Pew



The Easter Season is done, Pentecost has come and gone and we are back in Ordinary Time, a time for us to listen and learn more, a time for us to deepen the reflections we had during the seasons of Lent and Easter. Recently I have noticed I am out of sync, not running on all eight cylinders, missing the beat, and not playing well with others, etc. I think you get my drift, and because of this I am inadvertently “hurting” others. This is not my intention, but it is happening, and it is something I need to fix.

So, I have taken some time to look back, to determine what I did to get me here, and after thoroughly searching I still can't figure it out. However, I did notice there were a few minor things that I am not doing regularly, things I routinely performed daily or weekly, now I am not performing them with the scheduled routine I once did, and I am wondering if this is the reason I am out of sync with myself and out of sync with the people I truly care for?

These were simple things, things that were once routine, and now I easily accept the occasion of “skipping” them in lieu of something else, something that at the time seems to be more important, and needing to be done then, not being able to postpone it.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, 735 says, “He, then, gives us the “pledge” or “first fruits” of our inheritance: the very life of the Holy Trinity, which is to love as “God (has) loved us.” Love is our true destiny. We do not find the meaning of life by ourselves alone – we find it with another. I am blessed for I have a few people who truly care for me, who love me. God created us, not to be alone, but to be with others, the Church functions in Community, one body, and we all are part of the one body.

If you too are struggling with being in sync, finding your place, or just being yourself, perhaps going back to the basics will help return you to who you want to be. Try not to take things for granted as though they are expected, but rather be thankful and return the gift of love to the giver.

Talk with people, have a conversation, do not talk to them as though you were a professor and giving a lecture, but rather with compassion and understanding. Finally, share the love, remember Jesus' words, “Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.” (Matthew 25).

Remember we are all created in His image, men and women alike, so when we are looking at our loved ones, our friends, are we seeing them, or are we seeing Jesus? I know, my vision has been a little blurred lately, my eyeglasses are just a little out of focus, so I am going to give my glasses a real good cleaning, get them adjusted, put them back on, so that I can truly focus on “seeing” Jesus.
