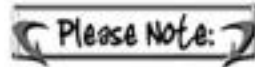

Perspective from the Pew



I really enjoy listening to the radio, especially the older songs – I can understand the words – the rock music of the 70's. Today I smirk a little when I think of the titles of the songs, *Bat Out of Hell*, *Renegade*, and of course *Highway to Hell*.

I have often heard the road to Hell is paved with good intentions. If you ask me, I think it's more likely to be paved with bad intentions, but the fact remains that people sometimes do very bad things for the very best reasons, better known by theologians as "a misdirected good".

Even compassion can do harm when you show it in the wrong way, and the only guarantee against making that kind of mistake is the virtue of obedience. Granted, there are times when we are called upon to resist authority. But most of the time, we have to trust that those in authority – secular authority like teachers, parents, police and firefighters, know what they're doing and know more than we do.

I find it baffling how people are so quick to accept the voice of authority when it comes to medicine, law, plumbing, dentistry and auto repair, but consider themselves experts when it comes to theology.

I realize that's hard to hear, but Saint Paul himself says, "Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God" (Rom 13:1).

Our community has begun a journey, with our Bishop guiding us, toward discipleship and stewardship. We need to pause and reflect upon his words, his rationale, and we need to trust. I know that is hard for some of us, but we have to try, we need guidance for we do not want our actions to be a "misdirected good" which puts us on the *Highway to Hell*.
